A specialty stop on this year's Art All Day Map is the Community Outreach Garage in East Trenton. The C.O.G. is a community bike shop created by Trenton Cycling Revolution focused on giving folks the tools they need to access affordable and fun transportation. The C.O.G. offers programs such as:

- Learn-a-Bike: Bike repair classes monthly
- Earn-a-Bike: Volunteer to earn a bicycle
- Pedal it Forward: Kids bike re-homing and bike-pairing for those who need transportation
- Trenton Bike Share: Bicycles that are free for the community to use and return.
